PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

The Town of Hilton Head Island is now fully open. Restaurants, stores, activities, and destinations have no capacity restrictions.

Fully vaccinated individuals do not have to wear masks in any setting. However, Players Club will continue to follow the strict sanitizing protocol that have been in place for the past year, at least until Labor Day, at which time, we will evaluate procedures going forward, based on health department guidelines. Spinnaker has announced they will not open the health club until July 1, 2021 at the earliest.

Lead times for many products, such as furniture and appliances, have increased dramatically, which is delaying implementation of our ongoing refurbishment plans. We had hoped to have the sofas and loveseats replaced in the remaining 37 units by Memorial Day. At present, the estimate time for shipment is six months.

We were also in the process of getting quotes and samples for replacing the dining room furniture. Currently, it is a 6-month lead time just to get samples. Hopefully, these lead times will shorten as the economy gets more and more back to normal. However, we were able to get all the bathroom mirrors and lighting upgraded before the backlogs occurred. Also, tile is being replaced in bathrooms as occupancy rates allow.

We hope everyone will be able to take advantage of their time at Players Club going forward this year.

As always, the Board welcomes communications from Players Club owners. Any comments, concerns, or suggestions are appreciated and discussed with the entire Board and management staff to find ways to improve Players Club for everyone. Please feel free to contact any of us via e-mail.
