MESSAGE FROM YOUR BOARD

Happy New Year to everyone. We hope you had a joyous season.

We have some news for you that should improve some aspects of the operations of Players Club. Our management company, VRI, which is a subsidiary of Interval International exchange company, is now a part of the Marriott Vacation Club family. A merger between Interval International and Marriott Vacation Club was begun in August of 2018 and is now complete. This gives Players Club access to all of Marriott Vacation Club's operations, such as accounting systems, staff support and training, and vendor discounts for Players Club purchases. This opens up access to Players Club for vendors and pricing that we never had before for our purchases. We are looking forward to this association increasing the efficiency of Players Club operations.

On November 1, 2019 the Annual Owners Meeting was held at Players Club. During this meeting, the owners were given a financial report on Players Club, an update on projects that were completed and plans for next year's projects. In addition, the results of the election for 2 Board of Directors was announced. Keith Martin and Jim Bard were re-elected to a 3-year term.



During the question and answer session, one of the topics that was most interesting to the owner's present was concerning the amount of delinquency that Players Club experiences. We thought it was important enough to discuss here so everyone can see it. The industry average delinquency rate for timeshares is approximately 40%. This means that, on average, 60% of the timeshare owners must shoulder the total cost of their resorts since the other 40% are non-paying. In our case, Players Club only has a delinquency rate of 20%, one of the best in VRI's portfolio of 125 resorts. This is further mitigated by VRI's aggressive efforts to rent the non-paying units. Income from this effort puts the net effect of delinquency at about 16%. While this is not ideal, it is far less than what owners of most other resorts have to contend with. Hopefully, the association with Marriott Vacation Club will give Players Club an avenue for even more rental income.

As always, the Board welcomes communications from Players Club owners. Any comments, concerns, or suggestions are appreciated and discussed with the entire Board and management staff to find ways to improve Players Club for everyone. Please feel free to contact any of us via email.
